In 2017, his production of Thornton Wilder's "Skin on our teeth" at the Theater an der Rott (D) received the Lower Bavarian Integration Prize.

In 2023, his play "drinking moonmilk now and always / i dont care about your solarplexus" was awarded the author's prize for contemporary drama by Theaterallianz Austria. The world premiere took place at the Bregenz Festival in 2024.
